Workshops

Workshops at the festival are highly popular among ticket holders and the Galway community. Gerry Savage's "Absolute Beginners" workshop is a consistent highlight, while past offerings covered strumming techniques, rhythm, harmonies, and broader music topics like marketing and songwriting.

In 2024, we're introducing two workshop tracks: one for beginners to intermediates and another for advanced ukulele enthusiasts.



Flashmobs

The annual Galway Ukulele Festival flashmobs have become a cherished tradition. Over 250 Festival-goers, armed with ukuleles, spontaneously break into music at Cross Street and High Street for one song, creating moments of surprise, joy, and unity. This delightful street performance has also turned into an online sensation, with the 2023 and 2022 flashmobs reaching millions of viewers worldwide.



Concerts

Held on Friday and Saturday evenings, each concert features a dynamic lineup of three distinct musician categories, promising a diverse and thrilling experience. Additionally, our Saturday afternoon concert offers a family-friendly atmosphere, catering to a broader audience. In 2024, we're excited to introduce a Sunday closing concert tailored to our local ukulele community, adding a perfect note to conclude the festivities. Our headline musicians consistently represent an international standard of excellence.



Pop Up Performances

Our pop-up performances, a festival tradition, occur at 6pm on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Three talented groups of international-standard musicians play three songs each at different pubs in the Latin Quarter, promoting their weekend performances and enhancing festival visibility. This year, weather permitting, we'll take the pop-ups to the streets of Galway.

 merch at international ukulele events.

Relaxed Playalongs:

From the Early Bird Hoots, Ukulele Ceilidh Strumchtime, to Pints n' Ukes, these gatherings unite up to 100 ukulele enthusiasts in harmonious strumming and singing.

Attendees access the festival songbooks online and receive print outs at the free events, perfect for mingling with fellow musicians over a refreshing pint. In 2024, we're even planning an outdoor gathering to add a natural touch to our musical community.

For the 2024 festival, based on positive feedback, we're expanding free event offerings. Introducing "Pub of the Day," a rotating venue where attendees can connect outside the official schedule, fostering a stronger sense of community and lasting connections among participants


Social Media
